Law No. 903 of December 9, 1977, also known as the Anselmi Law, established the equal treatment of men and women in the workplace by prohibiting any discrimination based on gender in terms of access to employment and equal pay. It marked an historic step towards gender equality in Italy.

01. Angela Buttiglione, the first woman to anchor a national news program in 1975 and later to host Rai Parlamento.

02. Tina Anselmi, the first woman to head a ministry. In 1976, she served as Minister of Labor in the Andreotti III government.

03. On November 4, 1976, Maria Adelaide Aglietta was elected leader of the Radical Party, the first woman to hold that position in Italy.

04. Diana Bracco, president and CEO of the Bracco Group since 1977, became the first woman elected president of Assolombarda in 2005.

05. On May 22, 1978, Law 194 regulating abortion was passed, later confirmed by a referendum in 1981.

06. Lina Wertmüller directs Giancarlo Giannini on set. She was the first woman in history to be nominated for an Oscar for Best Director in 1977.

07. Carolina Morace made her Serie A debut at age 14 during the 1978-1979 season, winning 12 league titles and 12 top scorer awards. In 1999, she became the first woman to coach a professional men's team, Viterbese in Serie C1.

08. In 1979, Nilde Iotti became the first female Speaker of the Chamber of Deputies, a position she held for nearly 13 years - longer than anyone else to date.

09. Sara Simeoni, Olympic high jump champion in 1980, was the first woman in the world to clear 2 meters in 1978: her record of 2.01 meters stood for 29 years.

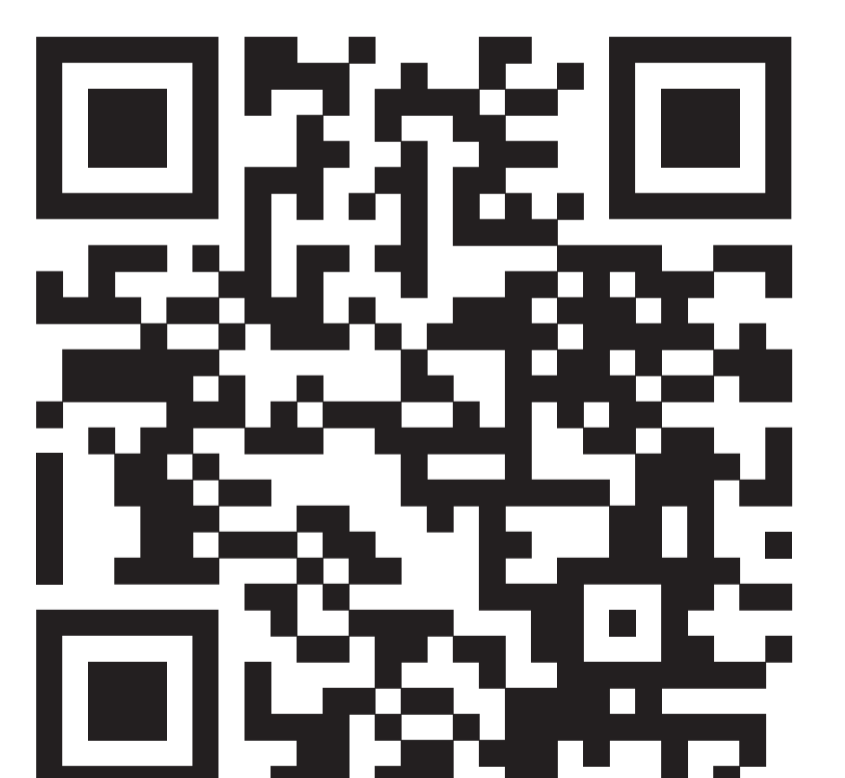
