



++ Alla Camera ok unanime al ddl femminicidio, è legge ++

(ANSA) - ROMA, 25 NOV - La Camera dei deputati ha approvato all'unanimità il ddl femminicidio che, in questo modo, diventa legge. Il provvedimento che quest'estate anche al Senato aveva incassato un via libera bipartisan, introduce all'interno del codice penale il nuovo articolo 577-bis sul reato di femminicidio. Si tratta di una fattispecie specifica di omicidio che prevede l'ergastolo per chiunque provochi la morte di una donna per discriminazione, odio o prevaricazione o mediante atti di controllo, possesso o dominio.



Law 181/2025 introduced the standalone crime of femicide into the Criminal Code, punishable by life imprisonment. The legislation, strongly supported by the executive branch, was approved with broad bipartisan consensus.
